1. **Project Name:** South Winnequah Road Improvements Project

6. **Project Description/Justification (briefly indicate the size, location, type of projects or purchases, and time schedule involved in implementation.)**

Initial design review and planning for improvements to South Winnequah Road began in 2018. The area to be improved is from Schluter Road to Bridge Road.

Tentative list of road improvements includes:

Removal of bump-outs, construct several parking in-bays, construct three speed humps, construct minor storm water improvements at Graham Street, mill and overlay of asphalt surface, completely new bike lane and pavement markings.

Option 1: road improvements with no sidewalk and no preparation for future sidewalks:

Construction: \$765,000
Bidding & A/O: \$85,000
Contingency: \$63,750
Total: \$913,750

Option 2: road improvements with no sidewalk, with preparation for future sidewalks:

Construction: \$855,000
Bidding & A/O: \$95,000
Contingency: \$71,250
Total: \$1,021,250

Option 3: road improvements with sidewalk and curb adjustments:

Construction: \$1,125,000
Bidding & A/O: \$125,000
Contingency: \$93,750
Total: \$1,343,750

Option 4: road improvements, moving west curb 8 ft to east, with a shared-use pathway (bicycle and pedestrian) behind new curb line.

Construction: \$1,155,000
Bidding & A/O: \$128,500
Contingency: \$96,250
Total: \$1,379,750

7. **Total Project Cost:**

Range: \$913,750 - \$1,379,750, depending on Option chosen.
