Re: Act 97 – Alcohol Sales Starting at 6 a.m.

Dear Municipal Clerk:

Effective December 21, 2011, a new state law will change the hours for Class "A" and "Class A" retailers to allow alcohol sales to begin at 6:00 a.m. The name of the new law is 2011 Wisconsin Act 97 and it amends Wis. Stats. 125.32(3)(b) and 125.68(4)(b). A copy of Act 97 is enclosed for your reference.

The purpose of this letter is to determine if your municipality will amend its current ordinance to allow alcohol sales to begin at 6:00 a.m. Please send an email to me at jessica.gomez@roundys.com stating if your municipality will amend its Class "A" and "Class A" closing hours to reflect the new state law. It is my understanding an amendment to the ordinance will involve certain municipal board approvals and may not be a quick process. For implementation purposes at store level and to achieve honest communication to our customers, please provide me with an anticipated time frame on when the new ordinance will be approved.

If your ordinance does not require an amendment to allow alcohol sales to begin at 6:00 a.m., please send an email to me confirming same.


Also, if your municipality will not allow alcohol sales at 6:00 a.m., please let me know as well.

Good morning Jessica,

Our License Review Committee discussed this at its December 13th meeting. The consensus was we will make no changes at this time. If enough establishments request a change, then it may be considered.

Our hours remain as is: alcohol sales may not occur until 8:00 a.m.

Reconsideration would require the LRC to meet, Ordinance revisions drafted with legal counsel review, and a possible second LRC meeting. Then consideration would be taken up by the City Council, who may require amendments. There are usually two readings of Council issues before approval. Final approval of an Ordinance amendment could take two to three months.
