Overall, the Commission wants to edit and update the book to reflect current interviews on each landmark such as its location in relation to other places. We are still waiting to hear if the Commission receives the grant for the new booklet. We also discussed the following questions:

- Whether Deb Offerdahl's house is Schneider's and not Paynters? Ray emailed daughter Mary; the book says Paynter; news reports say Schneider.
- Is GW part of our area?

The Commission discussed that at the next meeting can we find someone who could take high quality black & white photos of the new landmarks to be added to the book (ideas included a local printing or media or Monona company, or MATC photography students.)

The Commission discussed asking some senior citizens if they can provide us with information on the history of Monona and it was discussed we can do this in the spring.
