

# WHAT IS A MASTER PLAN?

- Evolving, long-term planning document
- Establishes the framework and key elements of facility improvements
- Identify funding sources and strategies need to complete master plan
- Describe a development schedule; which improvements should be done first?

# HOW DOES A PROJECT HAPPEN IN MONONA?

- Capital Budget Process
  - 5 year plan is updated each year
    - Parks & Recreation Staff presents to Parks & Recreation Board
    - Parks & Recreation Board makes recommendation to Mayor
    - Mayor decides what projects to include in Mayoral Capital Budget
    - City Council votes on Mayoral budget and can add or delete projects
  - City borrows in (1) year increments
    - Just because a project is included in the 5 year capital plan does not necessarily mean that it will happen
  - Capital Budget approved usually in late October – early November
    - Projects are designed/engineered and reviewed by multiple committees
      - Parks & Recreation Board, Plan Commission, Facilities Committee
    - City Council ultimately approves/denies project based on multiple factors
