This permit is issued with the condition that the first floor (excluding the basement or crawlway) of any new or substantially improved building shall be at or above the flood protection elevation (which is a point two (2) feet above the regional flood elevation). The fill elevation shall be one (1) foot or more above the regional flood elevation extending at least fifteen (15) feet beyond the limits of the structure. The basement or crawlway floor may be placed at the regional flood elevation if it is floodproofed to the flood protection elevation. No basement or crawlway floor is allowed below the regional flood elevation.
