Motion by Mr. Kramarz, seconded by Ms. Wartenweiler, to approve the minutes of the February 14, 2023 License Review Committee meeting. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

6.A Consideration of Application for Amplified Device Permits for The East Side Club, 3735 Monona Drive, for the period of May – September 2023.

Mr. Crahen explained they are having the same music schedule as last year, which is Thursdays and Sundays, with the exception of Labor Day and Memorial Day. Last year there were no issues with the neighbors and the events were kept under control. The neighbors were sent both the music schedule and a notice for this meeting. Chief Chaney reported there were three calls for service, however when officers responded to these calls there were no warnings or citations issued.

Motion by Mr. Kimmell, seconded by Ms. Wartenweiler, to approve Amplified Device Permits for The East Side Club, 3735 Monona Drive, for the period of May – September 2023. Motion carried.

6.B Consideration of Temporary Class “B” Fermented Malt Beverage and “Class B” Wine Retailer’s Licenses for The Friends of Monona Senior Center, Vice President Susan Manning, 1108 Nishishin Tr. NE, Monona, WI 53716, for the Period of July 18, 2023 and August 1, 2023.

Chair Wood explained that the Parks and Recreation department sold the beer at these events in the past but is not doing so this year. The Friends of Monona Senior Center is requesting that these two events have beer and wine. The Friends group originally requested all four of their events have beer and wine however, the state statutes limit the number of temporary wine licenses to two in a 12-month period. Discussion followed regarding why the statutes restrict the number of wine licenses but not the number of beer licenses.
